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**PRESCRIPTION PRODUCTS:**

The following should be discontinued **2 days prior** to testing.

- Astelin
- Astepro
- Patanase
- Singulair

The following must be discontinued **3 days prior** to allergy testing

- Allegra
- Clarinex
- Claritin
- Phenergan
- Promethazine
- PBZ (tripelennamine)
- Zyrtec (Cetirizine)

The following must be discontinued **7 days prior** to testing.

- Amitriptyline (Nortriptyline, Pamelor)
- Antivert (Dramamine, Bonine, Marezine)
- Hydroxyzine
- Doxepin
- Optimine
- Periactin (Cyproheptadine)
- Polaramine
- Vistaril
- Xyzal

**OVER-THE COUNTER PRODUCTS**

The following medications should be discontinued **3 days prior** to testing.

**\* If you have any questions about the active ingredients in the following products, please feel free to call the office and one of the nurses will be happy to speak with you. Note that “PM” preparations usually contain an antihistamine.**
