

## MEDICATIONS THAT WILL INTERFERE WITH ALLERGY SKIN TESTING

### PRESCRIPTION PRODUCTS:

The following should be discontinued **2 days prior** to your allergy testing appointment.

- Astelin, Azelastine, Astepro or Patanase
- Singulair
- Zflo

The following should be discontinued **3 days prior** to your allergy testing appointment.

- Clarinex
- Imipramine
- Phenergan
- Promethazine
- PBZ (Triplennamine)
- Dymista

The following should be discontinued **7 days prior** to your allergy testing appointment.

- Amitriptyline (Nortriptyline, Pamelor)
- Antivert (Bonine, Marezine, Meclizine)
- Hydroxyzine
- Doxepin
- Periactin (Cyproheptadine)
- Polaramine
- Vistaril

### OVER-THE COUNTER PRODUCTS:

The following medication should be discontinued **24 hours prior** to your allergy testing appointment.

- Pepcid (Famotidine)

The following medications should be discontinued **3 days prior** to your allergy testing appointment

**\*If you have any questions about the active ingredients in the following products, please feel free to call the office and one of the nurses will be happy to speak with you. Note that "PM" preparation usually contains an antihistamine.**
